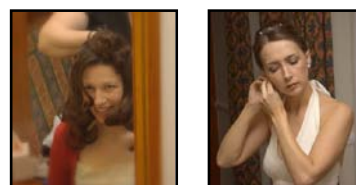
Please note that all pricing below **includes VAT** at the relevant rates. You should always ensure you are comparing like with like when comparing quotations. This pricelist is valid for bookings made before 30th June 2011.

Basic Photography Fee €850

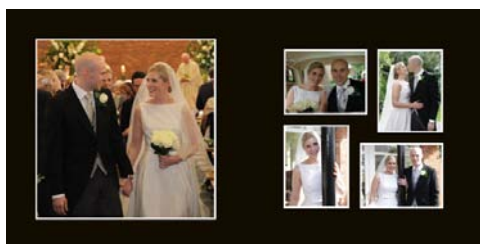
This is the standard photography fee for the day. It covers photography starting at the church (or alternative wedding venue) and continuing through to the early part of the reception. I shoot the wedding in colour but the photographs can be made available in any combination of colour, b&w or sepia. The basic photography fee **does not include** albums, photos, DVDs etc. These must be selected from the menu of options below.

Photographs of the bride at home/hotel €175

This is an optional extra service. I will visit your home or hotel on the morning of the wedding to capture some of the preparation atmosphere. This typically includes photographs with bridesmaids, parents etc.



Conventional Wedding Albums ... from €400



I currently use top of the range Italian albums from the Tony Sarlo range. As a guideline, a €400 album will get you a 30-shot album holding up to 10x10inch sized photos (landscape or portrait).



Prices vary upwards from here depending on style, photo size, photo capacity etc. Two sample album pages are shown above – one with a 10x10inch print and one with four smaller apertures.

Digital Albums ... from €850

Digital albums are effectively digital books .. sometimes referred to as coffee table books. The photos are printed directly onto the pages. The pages are made of heavy duty thick high quality photographic surfaced pages. One of the advantages of digital albums is that you can include far more photographs than in a conventional album of the same size. They are also more modern in style than conventional wedding albums.

Conventional Parent Albums ... from €150

These are physically smaller albums that the couple can order for parents, relatives, guests, special friends etc.

Individual photo reprint orders

- 10x8inch ... €30

- 8x6inch ... €25

Note: If you opt for the DVD option below, you can organise your own reprints from this at a much lower cost.

DVD option

€350 ... if ordered instead of an album

€150 ... if ordered in addition to ordering an album

As an alternative to sourcing albums and/or additional prints through me, you can choose to purchase the images in high quality jpeg format on CD or DVD and then source your own wedding albums and additional prints. This allows you the freedom to create as many or as few copies of the photos as you choose at a fixed price.

The number of images provided on the DVDs depends on the photography style e.g.

formal/conventional style vs. reportage or contemporary. However, a figure in excess of 150 photos would be typical. I would advise caution in comparing photographers by the number of photos they offer. It's easy to offer a thousand photographs - the quality of the photographs is the real differentiator.

Bookings

A booking fee of €200 applies with a further 50% of the remaining balance payable four weeks prior to the wedding. The remaining balance is due on delivery of albums/prints/DVDs etc.
